Dear Ms. Clemonds,

I am writing to offer support to the Door of Hope rapid rehousing program funded by the American Rescue Plan Act.

When eligible, we will offer the following items as needed for up to three times to program participants at Door of Hope between January 2023 and December 2026:

**Baby items:** (a standard baby care kit includes (1 baby wash, 1 baby lotion, 1 wipes, 1 pack diapers, 1 can of formula, bottles, or nursing supplies. The average cost to MINO is approximately \$30 and baby gear, as available, these items are generally in kind and are gently used.)

**Cleaning supplies:** (the average cleaning kit contains (All purpose cleaner, bleach, 2 cleaning sponges, dishwashing liquid, laundry detergent, and paper towels. The average cost to our agency is approximately \$10 per bag/kit)

**Personal hygiene products:** (the basic personal hygiene kit is made up of 2 bars of soap, deodorant (1 per adult) , 1 toothpaste, toothbrushes (1 per family member), 1 shampoo, 1 conditioner, razors (1 per adult) , toilet paper (1 four roll pack per family) The cost to our program is \$10 (+for larger families)

**Feminine Hygiene products:** The standard feminine hygiene kit contains 18-21 pads and tampons, and panty shields). These items are donated to us by private donors and the National Council of Jewish Women and their subsidiaries. The average cost of a box or bag of tampons and pads are between \$5 and \$10 depending on the contents.

In addition, if we receive called from persons fleeing domestic violence or human trafficking and they require housing, we will contact Door of Hope at Providence Housing for availability and eligibility.

We look forward to working with you.
